



## **Clothing and Furniture Bank**

Sunday Breakfast Rescue Mission (SBRM) is a non-profit organization which ministers in the name of Jesus Christ to the physical and spiritual needs of the homeless and disadvantaged people in the Philadelphia area. SBRM does not receive government funding but relies on the generous contributions of caring individuals, families, churches, and businesses. Client referrals are received from over 50 agencies and churches.

Clients can choose from a variety of functional furniture, housewares, and clothing, at no cost, from our existing furniture bank inventory. To receive service from the SBRM Clothing and Furniture Bank, clients must a) be referred from a church or agency, b) must have been homeless within the past two years, and c) must live, work, or worship in Bucks County. Clients must also supply a list of needed items (see attached form) as well as provide their own transportation and movers or assistants to pick up the items from our location.

Please be sure to provide contact information for your client on the referral form as our Furniture Bank Coordinator will contact each client directly to set up an appointment and add them to our schedule. Referral forms without sufficient contact information will not be added to our referral list until they are completed.

Clients are strongly encouraged to arrive at the given time for their appointment and/or to cancel any appointment they are unable to keep. If you know that a client needs to reschedule an appointment, please have them contact us.
